Below, please state any information you would like us to know about your interests, etc. and why you would like to be the 2018 Ambassador of the Kinmount Fair.

Rules and Guidelines are as follows:

1. Candidates, male or female, single, non-parental, must be between the ages of 17 and 24 years as of August 1, 2018.
2. Must live in the Fenelon Falls Secondary School area or Haliburton Secondary School area and be a resident of his/her Fair district for six months.
3. Candidates must be able to attend to all Ambassador duties (see list of duties below for details) during the Kinmount Fair and for the 12-month period following. Prior to the program commencing, candidates should disclose any known scheduling conflicts (ie. work, school, travel plans.)
4. Candidates should appear in appropriate attire.
5. The program will include a private interview with judges, a short prepared speech (1 minute in length) on a topic related to Agriculture, the Environment or Agricultural Fairs, and a 140 character description of themselves (This 140 character description can be described as an elevator talk – you meet a potential employer on the elevator and have to sell yourself before you reach their floor), and a Question & Answer session on stage.
6. The program will be judged on the basis of:
 - Poise and composure
 - Character
 - Public speaking ability
 - General knowledge of the community and the fair
 - General knowledge of agriculture and current affairs
7. In the event the Ambassador crowned cannot complete their duties, the 1st runner up will assist.
8. The Ambassador is expected to attend various mutually agreed upon events on the Friday, Saturday and Sunday of the fair (ie: parade, ribbon and trophy presentations). The Ambassador should circulate the fair to interact with volunteers and the public.
9. The Ambassador is expected to attend to their fair duties in appropriate dress. Footwear should be suitable to standing and walking for long periods. While on duty, the Ambassador should wear tiara/medallion and sash.
10. The program will be limited to 5 candidates and the judges' decision is final.

In order for the winner to receive the \$500.00 they will be expected to:

1. Attend the remainder of the Kinmount Fall Fair and assist at various events, including but not limited to:
 - Warrior's Day Parade (Saturday)
 - Opening Ceremonies (Saturday)
 - Ribbon and trophy presentations (Friday – Sunday)
 - Exhibit hall
 - Circulate the fairgrounds (Friday – Sunday)
 - Organize and manage the children's races (Sunday)

2. Represent Kinmount Agricultural Society at various functions throughout the year, including but not limited to:
 - Local Fall Fair Parades (LEX, Bobcaygeon)
 - Christmas in the Village (December)
 - Kinmount Agricultural Society Annual General meeting (January)
 - Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies Convention (February)
 - Winterfest (February)
 - Canada Day (July)
 - Heritage Days, Highland Games, Moonlight Mania (July)
 - CNE Ambassador of the Fairs Program (August)
 - 2018 Kinmount Ambassador of the Fair Program
 - Attend at least one monthly meeting of the Kinmount Agricultural Society

In the event that the winner cannot represent the Kinmount Fair at all of the above events, the first runner-up will be asked to attend and the \$500.00 will be distributed between the two candidates as decided by the Kinmount Agricultural Society.

By signing this agreement, I confirm that I have received a copy of the above rules and regulations and that I understand the responsibilities that I must complete in order for me to receive the \$500.00 upon the end of my term as the Kinmount Fair Ambassador, should I be crowned with this title at the Kinmount Fair.

DUTIES OF THE 1st RUNNER_UP

1. Runner up should attend all three days of the fair.
2. Runner up will be present for the Warriors' Day Parade and during the opening ceremonies.
3. Runner up will assist the Ambassador with ribbon and trophy presentations.
4. Runner up will circulate the fair grounds meeting and greeting the public.
5. Runner up will assist in the exhibit hall on Saturday and Sunday during the fair.
6. Runner up will assist Ambassador in organizing and managing the Children's races on Sunday.
7. Runner up will assume the duties of the Ambassador should she/he be unable to fulfill them at any time during the fair or in the coming year.

All other candidates (2nd, 3rd and additional participants may participate in any/all of the above duties)

Notes for You

“Pre-judging” – personal interview by 3 judges

- You will be asked 7 questions prepared by the ambassador program committee
- You will be asked 1 question prepared by the judge
- You will be judged on the following criteria:
 - Pose and composure
 - Character
 - Public Speaking ability
 - General knowledge of the community and fair
 - General knowledge of agriculture and current affairs

“Your Public Presentation”

- 1 minute speech on a topic related to Agriculture, the Environment or Agricultural Fairs
- 140 character description of yourself. This 140 character description can be described as an elevator talk – you meet a potential employer on the elevator and have to sell yourself before you reach their floor
- Impromptu Question. All candidates will be given the same impromptu question. During each candidates turn, the other candidates will be sequestered.

“Clothing Suggestions”

This is a fair – you should feel comfortable. It is also a FAMILY fair – you should dress appropriately.

- Clothing suitable for Friday program, opening ceremonies (Saturday) and during public appearances on all three days of the fair.
- Comfortable shoes for walking the grounds.
- Sponsor’s sash to be worn during the Friday program.
- Ambassador sash and/or medallion to be worn Friday (after the program), Saturday, and Sunday.
- Runner up sash to be worn Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

Timetable for Contestants

****You are asked to conduct yourself in an appropriate manner at all times.***

****Remember you are our official meeters and greeters – be friendly, respectful, and courteous.***

****Wear your sash and/or medallion at all times, unless otherwise stated.***

Friday, August 31 - 1:00 p.m. meet at the Heritage Complex on the grounds. Please be prompt! You will meet the other contestants, receive your sash and have a chance to ask any last minute questions.

The personal interview with the judges will take place at 1:15 p.m.

2:00 p.m. SHARP the program will start. Each candidate will be officially introduced on stage. After the introduction of judges, the president's welcome, and the current fair ambassador's farewell speech, you will give your speech. After all candidates have spoken you will be presented with gifts and pictures will be taken. At the close of the program, the 2018 Ambassador and the runner up will be announced. The Ambassador will be presented with a medallion/tiara and the runner up will receive a sash. The runner up will assist the Ambassador during the fair and assume his/her duties should the Ambassador be unable to fulfill them during the coming year.

The Ambassador and runner up will officiate at events as scheduled (times to be discussed) and may be accompanied by one of the committee members.

Attendance at the dance is not an obligation. If you choose to attend the dance, do not wear your sash and/or medallion/tiara.

Saturday September 1 – 11:00 a.m. SHARP! You will meet Doug or one of the committee members at the railway station, downtown Kinmount to participate in the Warriors' Day Parade. **Please make sure you get into town early as the traffic will be heavy Saturday morning. Do not be late for the parade.** You will ride in the parade to the fair grounds and will be presented on stage during the opening ceremonies. Pictures will be taken following the opening. You will attend a brief reception in the secretary's office to meet dignitaries and tour the grounds.

The Ambassador and runner up will once again officiate at events as scheduled (times to be discussed).

Sunday September 2 – Times to be arranged. You will meet to give out ribbons and awards at the various events taking place. We will arrange a time suitable to all.

Here are some additional questions for the Ambassadors pertaining to their extracurricular involvement and Fair experiences.

1. Please share with us some background information.
 - Where do you live?
 - What level of education have you completed?
 - What are your plans for the future?
 - What hobbies or special interests do you have?
 - What volunteer activities do you participate in?
2. Why do you want to be the Kinmount Fair Ambassador? (or) What would make you a good Kinmount Fair Ambassador?
3. The Kinmount Fair attracts 1000's of people each year. What do you think makes the Kinmount Fair special and unique? (or) If someone was coming to the Kinmount Fair for the first time, what are two things that you would show them?
4. Tell us about your volunteer experience. What is one thing you have learned through volunteering?
5. What is one major thing that has happened in the news that interests you and why?
6. Name one thing, and explain what you could do to promote the Kinmount Fair and get more youth involved?
7. What is something you are proud about?

- What are your plans for the future?
- What are your feelings about your future job possibilities?
- What job do you think best suits your personality?
- What is the best part of the fair and why?
- Agriculture is very important. In your view, what is the most important part of agriculture?
- Name three other fairs and the months they take place in?
- What do you think a fair director does?
- If you could be anyone else for one week, who would you be and why?
- If there was a certain book you could read, tell us what it would be and why?
- Is there someone in your life who has influenced you in your major decisions? Tell us about it.
- If you could have one wish, what would it be and why?
- If I told you today that you could have a month off and not lose any time at school or work, where would you go and why?
- There are many fall fairs held each year across the country. Historically speaking, what is the origin of these annual events? How and why did they begin?
- Everyone has favourite memories of the Kinmount Fair. What are some of the things you enjoy about the Kinmount Fair? What is your favourite memory?
- What changes or attractions would you like to see considered for another year at the fair?
- If you were given \$10,000, what would you do with it?
