

In 2018, the Kinmount Pioneer Society will present the theme: "Pioneer Schools and School Children".

The exhibit will feature images of all the one-room pioneer schools in Victoria County, Haliburton County and relevant sections of Peterborough County. That's close to 200 pioneer schools!

Also featured will be teachers, school rules, text books, diaries, stories, special events, and tons of history relating to the pioneer education system. A replica classroom circa 1900 will be set up and manned by actual teachers. Children (actual and "aged out") can "sit in" on a lesson. Rumour has it there will be at least 2 lessons: cursive writing and reading clocks the old fashioned way! Clearly the lessons will be taught by "older" teachers, if you get the drift!

The display will also feature children's games and sports from a century ago.

Local authors and local history books will also be on display.

The Tea Garden is back with special entertainment on the Tea Garden stage. The local craft guild will be demonstrating pioneer crafts. Special features will also include archeology, fur harvesters, historical societies and much more!

The modern era will invade the Heritage Centre on Saturday (Sept 1) with a special visit by Batman, Spiderman and other superheroes. Fans can have their photos taken with the superheroes after the Parade. We will also be holding a "Superhero Costume Contest". Kids (and others!) can dress up as their favourite Superhero and strut their stuff on the Tea Garden Stage. Prizes for the best costumes!
