5. All entries exhibiting spoilage will be disqualified.
6. In sections 39 and 40, syrup bottles are allowed.
7. Refrigeration is not available.
8. Freezer entries should be fully defrosted at entry time.

 - c. Photos may be coloured or black & white, at the exhibitor's choice, must be printed on photographic paper, and mounted on construction paper only, with a maximum border of 1".
Other mountings may cause the photo to be disqualified.
 - d. Exhibitors mailing their photographs are responsible to ensure that they are appropriately packaged to prevent damage.
 - e. All exhibitors should prepare a listing (on any entry form, if available) showing the class number (44B) and the section name and number (1 through 12). If your membership for 2018 is not paid, enclose your \$12.00 membership fee, your complete mailing address, telephone number and, if possible, an e-mail address, to be used in the event questions arise regarding your entries. Entry tags will be prepared for you, based on the information you provide.
